Name a Seat Policy: (Please read before signing)

By submitting this form, I acknowledge that my donation will be used to support Uptown Film Center's Capital Campaign.

This pledge does not in any way impact existing pledges to Uptown Film Center.

Payment must be received in full before inscriptions can be affixed to the seat.

I understand that the plaque is symbolic of the donation and does not constitute "ownership" of the seat, including without limitation, reserving use of the seat containing such plaque for any screenings or events. Plaque locations will be determined at Uptown Film Center's discretion. Uptown Film Center retains the right to relocate the location of the plaque at any time, as well as, in rare instances, remove the inscription on a seat.

Uptown Film Center will honor all applications on a first come, first serve basis. Forms will be accepted starting October 2025. Uptown Film Center reserves the right to limit the number of seats that any one donor household may name.

Plaques will be installed once the building of the Film Center is completed and opened. The seat shall bear the plaque with the inscription for a term ending in the twenty years from opening.

A maximum of 48 characters (spaces not included in this count) is permitted as a proposed inscription on the plaque. Logos, images, graphics, and objects will not be permitted. No commercial statements or advertising of any kind are permitted.

Uptown Film Center will select the font and size at its sole discretion, and all inscriptions shall be subject to the approval of Uptown Film Center. Once inscribed on the seat, donors will not be able to amend their inscriptions.
